W.G. Rhea Public Library Hotspot Policy

Who Can Check out a Hotspot?

- Patron must be 18 years of age.
- Patron must have a valid and current W.G. Rhea Public Library card in good standing with zero fines for the entire household.
- Patron must have a current photo I.D., driver's license, passport or military I.D.
- Patron must read, understand and sign a borrower's agreement in the presence of a Library staff member.

Hotspot Use Guidelines:

- The Hotspot checkout is for 7 days. One per checkout per household.
- The Hotspot may not be renewed.
- A Hotspot may be reserved. Once returned, a patron must wait one week before placing another reserve or checking one out.
- Note to Parents/Guardians: Hotspots <u>ARE NOT</u> equipped with filtering software. Parents/Guardians are responsible for monitoring what their children access on the Internet through these devices.

Replacement Costs for Damaged or Lost Hotspot:

•	Mobile Hotspot	\$100
•	Hotspot Wall Plug	\$ 10
•	Hotspot Power Cord	\$ 10

Fines and Liabilities:

- Overdue fines are \$10.00 per day until returned. There is No grace-period.
- Overdue Hotspots will be deactivated within 24 hours after the due date.
- Patron must return the Hotspot to the Circulation Desk. A \$25.00 charge will be placed on the patron's account if are returned in the book drop or to another library. Hotspot must be kept in a temperature-controlled environment. DO NOT LEAVE IT IN YOUR VEHICLE.
- The patron is responsible for ALL costs associated with loss or damage while the Hotspot is checked out on their card.
- Patron must sign a Borrower's Agreement upon checkout of the Hotspot to indicate that they have read, and understand, and accept the terms of the Hotspot lending policy.
