W. G. Rhea Public Library Digital Collection Policy

The W. G. Rhea Public Library's collection includes a variety of formats, which include, but not limited, to books, periodicals, DVD's and Compact Disks. The Library also provides free access to a number of online databases made available through the Tennessee Electronic Library.

At the present time, the Library pays for digital books and audiobooks to be added to the Advantage program as part of the Regional eBook and Audiobook Download System. These are selected by the Library Director, based on recommendations and circulation numbers in reports from the Overdrive website. Patrons may use this free service providing they have a library card in good standing.

As demand for new technologies or formats increases, the library may expand the collection to include other formats. Online databases will be selected based on the needs of the community and funding limitations.
